UNFINISHED BUSINESS

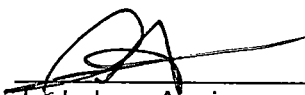
1. Discussion and possible action pertaining to vandalism within the City of Page:
Conley is updating the presentation with new information.

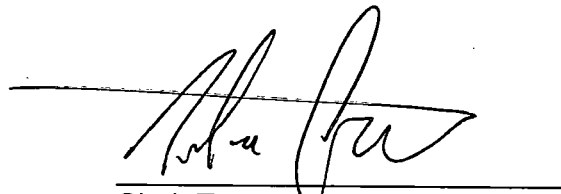
NEW BUSINESS
