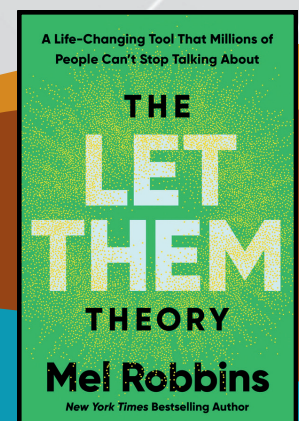

**Page Public Library supported and hosted multiple programs. These programs promoted community building engagement, provided accessible educationt, and supported local students.**

### 4th of July Games

On the Fourth of July, the library hosted a variety of games and contests in the city park for the community to enjoy. Activities included a watermelon-eating contest, pie-eating contest, water-shooter contest, sack race, and a community-wide water fight to close out the event. The celebration was well attended and provided a fun and memorable way for the library to engage with the community while celebrating the Fourth of July together.

### Jurassic Library: The Great Escape

“Jurassic Library: The Great Escape” was an after-hours, library-wide family adventure that invited families to work together to help recapture escaped dinosaurs before they could take over the library. Participants followed clues, completed challenges, and encountered dinosaurs throughout the library as they worked to complete their mission. The event provided an exciting and interactive experience that encouraged teamwork, problem-solving, and family participation. The program was well received and had a total attendance of 59 participants.

### Makerspace Open House

The Makerspace at Page Public Library has officially opened, with 67 community members attending the kickoff event to learn about this exciting new resource. Through the Makerspace, patrons can now access a variety of equipment by appointment, including 3D printers, a laser cutter, Cricut machines, a heat press, and a die-cut machine. This new service expands the library’s offerings and provides community members with opportunities to explore creativity, learn new skills, and bring their ideas to life.

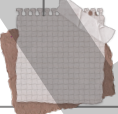
