REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
July 17, 2024**

A Regular Substance Abuse Task Force Meeting was held at 5:30 p.m. on July 17, 2024, at Page City Hall in Page, Arizona. Chair Matthew Lasslo, Member Michael Barnes, Member Ricky Cottrell, and Member Camilla Adams were present. Vice Chair Brittany Hansen and Member Christopher Hansen appeared virtually. Council Liaison David Auge was present.

CALL TO ORDER

Chair Lasslo called the meeting to order at 5:37 p.m.

MINUTES

Regular Substance Abuse Task Force Meeting – June 19, 2024

Vice Chair Hansen made a motion to approve the Minutes. That motion was seconded by Member Michael Barnes and passed unanimously.

HEAR FROM THE CITIZENS

No citizen addressed the Substance Abuse Task Force.

COMMUNICATIONS

Discussion only from Page Police Department on criminal activities involving substance abuse
Chief Lange appeared virtually stating he was at the Arizona Association of Chiefs of Police, Law Enforcement Summit. During the conference with the United States Attorney General, shared that the U.S. had seized 123 million fentanyl pills in 2023 and half of those seizures were in Arizona. Yesterday in Page, there was an arrest that involved fentanyl.

Discussion only from Page Magistrate Court updates on Drug Court and its participants
Magistrate Hettinger appeared and stated the graduation from Recovery Court for Austin Begay went very well. The next graduation is on August 21, 2024, at 4:30 p.m. Two participants should be graduating. We did have one participant who re-offended and terminated from Recovery Court and who is in a residential center but still enrolled. Alcohol was involved in seventy-four percent of the arrests this past month.

Discussion only from Encompass about any updates on their substance abuse programs
Member Matthew Lasslo stated the residential treatment center is back on the table. Financially they are hoping to partner with community entities to have a residential center with beds.
