EXECUTIVE SESSION

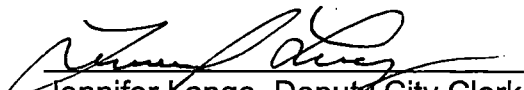

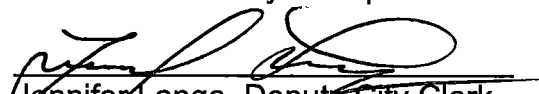
