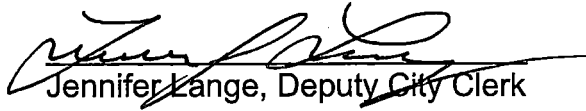

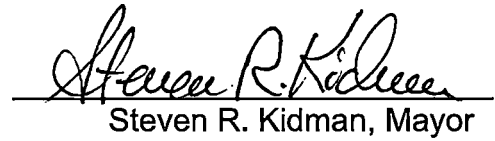
Staff directed to move forward as discussed in Executive Session.
