BMX / Pump

Track



Pump Track

Purpose: Skill building, flow, and fun for all ages.

Design:

- Made up of **rollers (small hills)**, **berms (banked turns)**, and sometimes **jumps**.
- Riders use **momentum and body movement ("pumping")** instead of pedaling to maintain speed.
- Usually **smaller and continuous**, often built in loops.
- Can be made of **asphalt, dirt, or modular composite material**.
- Great for **kids, families, BMX riders, and mountain bikers** to practice balance and control.
- Lower maintenance (especially asphalt ones).

Example use: Think of it like a skate park for bikes — riders roll around, pump through bumps, and flow through turns without pedaling much.



BMX Track

Purpose: Competitive racing and higher speed.

Design:

- Built for **BMX racing** — a straight or oval course with a **starting hill, large jumps, rhythm sections, and tight turns**.
- Riders **pedal and race** against each other; it's more about speed and competition.
- Typically **longer and wider** than a pump track.
- Requires more space, specific safety standards, and often **organized races or events**.
- Usually made of **packed dirt or clay** and needs more **regular maintenance**.

Example use: Like a dirt racetrack for bikes — riders line up on a starting gate and race around the course with big jumps and turns.
