

**PAGE YOUTH ADVISORY COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
October 21, 2024**

A Regular Meeting of the Page Youth Advisory Commission was held at 4:00p.m. on October 21, 2024, in Coconino Community College in Page, Arizona. Chair Trystan Conley presided. Members Dante Thompson, Emma Mallavia, Mia Burton, and Miriam Lassen were present. Michaela Long and Lily Crim were absent. Council Liaison Mike Farrow and Commission Liaison Jackelyne Aguirre were present.

Chair Conley called the meeting to order at 4:00p.m.

MINUTES

1. Minutes from the regular Youth Advisory Commission meeting on September 16, 2024:
Conley motioned to approve the minutes. Burton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

COMMUNICATIONS

1. Update provided by DJ Lister, Event Manager:
The Event Manager was not present. No discussion.
2. Update provided by Youth Advisory Commission members:
Conley discussed the voter registration drive during National Night Out. The event was considered a success and 4 citizens were registered. Voting information was distributed at the event.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Discussion only pertaining to the introduction of Lily Crim:
Crim was not present. No discussion.
2. Discussion only pertaining to council member liaison job description:
The commission reviewed the description. No discussion.
3. Discussion and possible action pertaining to the removal of Michaela Long from the Youth Advisory Commission:
The commission discussed Long's consecutive absences and multiple failed contact attempts. Thompson motioned to remove Long from the Youth Advisory

Commission. Conley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Discussion and possible action pertaining to rescheduling/canceling the regular Youth Advisory Commission meeting on December 16, 2024 due to a possible holiday conflict:

The commission discussed having a meeting before Unite to Light on December 6, 2024. Conley motioned to reschedule the December 16, 2024 meeting to December 2, 2024. Lassen seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Discussion and possible action pertaining to rescheduling the regular Youth Advisory Commission meeting on January 20, 2025 due to a holiday conflict:
Burton motioned to reschedule the meeting on January 20, 2025 to January 13, 2025. Lassen seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

6. Discussion and possible action pertaining to rescheduling the regular Youth Advisory Commission meeting on February 17, 2025 due to a holiday conflict:
Thompson motioned to reschedule the meeting on February 17, 2025 to February 10, 2025. Burton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

7. Discussion and possible action pertaining to rescheduling the regular Youth Advisory Commission meeting on March 17, 2025, due to a school break conflict:
Thompson motioned to reschedule the meeting on March 17, 2025 to March 24, 2025. Lassen seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

8. Discussion and possible action pertaining to the use of the PERA Club:
Each member discussed their ideal use of the PERA club. Farrow discussed coordinating a joint meeting with the Youth Advisory Commission, Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, Page Community Center, and Page Public Library at the PERA Club to discuss potential uses of the facility. Burton supported making the facility free for citizens to use. Payment alternatives were discussed such as accepting canned food donations for event/activity admission.

9. Discussion and possible action pertaining to the community service event Unite to Light:
No volunteers or recipients have registered for Unite to Light at the time of this meeting. Conley motioned to present Unite to Light to the public at the City Council meeting on November 13, 2024. Burton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

10. Discussion and possible action pertaining to volunteering during Christmas in the Park:
The Event Manager was not present. No discussion regarding volunteering at the event.

11. Discussion and possible action pertaining to a youth activity during Page's 50th anniversary:

Commission members were advised to present ideas for activities at the next meeting.

12. Discussion and possible action pertaining to Hub & Spoke Program - A Path Forward for recycling in Page:

JB Shaw the Recycling Coordinator for the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality presented the possibility of creating a recycling program in the City of Page. The board discussed a possible fee system, locations for the recycling plant, and how to staff the plant. Conley motioned to support bringing an ADEQ Hub & Spoke Program to the City of Page. Thompson seconded the motion. The motioned passed unanimously.
