SUBSTANCE ABUSE TASK FORCE FUNDING AVAILABLE

The City Substance Abuse Task Force shall, as necessary, allocate monies received into the Fund to itself and local organizations for the purpose of education, creating prevention or treatment projects and programs, or enhancing existing projects and programs designed to prevent or treat substance abuse.

Eligibility to apply for funding from the City of Page Substance Abuse Task Force program is subject to assessment criteria and guidelines.

Focus Areas

The Substance Abuse Task Force fund supports work in substance abuse prevention, education and treatment.

To be considered for funding, proposals must align with two or more Substance Abuse Task Force focus areas:

- Prevent drug and alcohol abuse.
- Collaborate with community partners to prevent and/or reduce substance abuse
- Provide education on the consequences of substance abuse.

How To Apply

Pick up an application at Page City Hall on 697 Vista Ave, in Page, Arizona, and submit to the City Clerk's Office.

Due to open meeting laws, a single monthly meeting of the task force (3rd Wednesday of each month) and the time needed for processing approved funding, applications need to be submitted to the City Clerk's office 60 days in advance of program, project, or event.

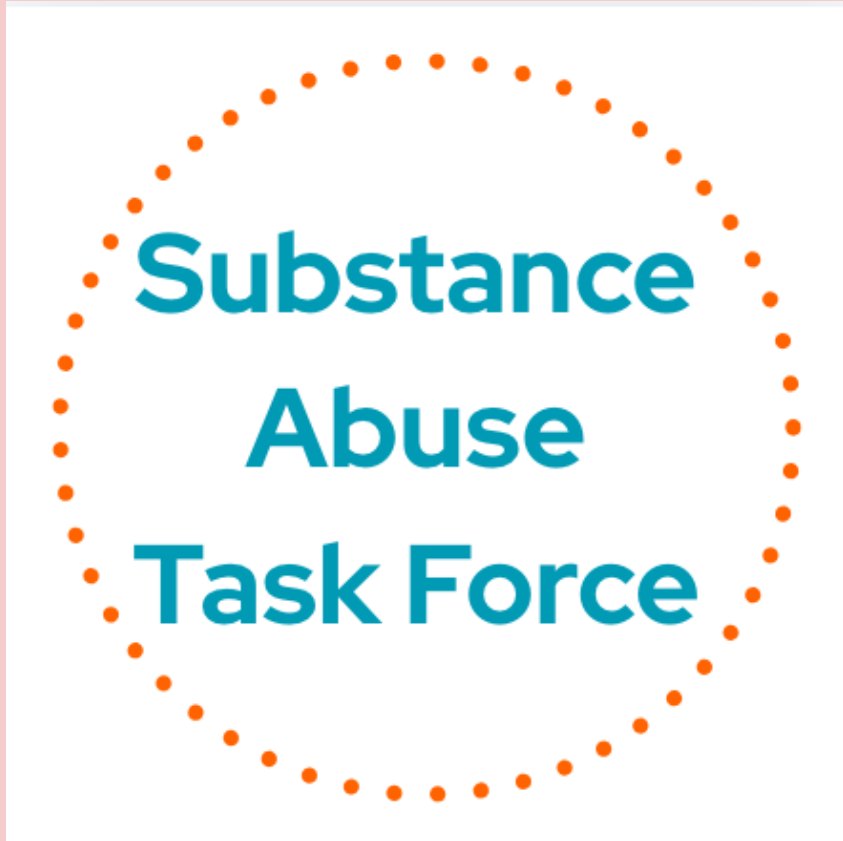

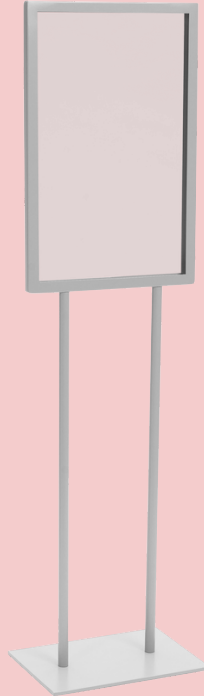
