### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

*Discussion and Possible Action Pertaining to the Design and Construction of an Inclusive Playground at Annex Park.*

Chair Baughman presented a project outline for the playground equipment and costs of an inclusive playground at Annex Park.

Member Redshirt asked if they could discuss item B before we move on with A.

There was a discussion.

*Discussion and Possible Action Pertaining to the FY27 Budget Recommendations*

City Manager Frank Marbury reviewed the projects included in the FY27 budget that staff are currently working on.

There was a discussion.

The Board recommendations for FY27 Budget:

1. Visibility Study – Recreation and Aquatic Center
2. Urban Trail System – Master Plan
3. Vermillion Park's - new playground equipment
4. Annex Park - Inclusive Playground Equipment
5. Vermillion View Trail - Glen Canyon Dam to Horseshoe Bend, with an Intergovernmental agreement with NPS
6. Pump Track

Motion was made by Vice-Chair Tenpenny to send our budget recommendation to council with the Urban Trail Master Plan, Annex Park Playground, Recreation Center Master Plan (including PERA Club pool design), the Middle school Visibility Workup, Vermillion Cliffs Playground, Vermillion View Trail, and Pump Track.

The motion was seconded by Member Woods and passed unanimously upon a vote.

Chair Baughman left the dais at 6:55.

## **City of Page Parks and Recreation Regular Meeting – May 4, 2026**

*Continued with the discussion and Possible Action Pertaining to the Design and Construction of an Inclusive Playground at Annex Park.*

Member Redshirt stated that the playground equipment was large but needed. Many people use the grass area, and we should keep some of it.

There was a discussion on how many pieces the city has at JCPMP. Would we be able to start small and add pieces to another budget?

Motion was made by Vice Chair Tenpenny to recommend the Annex Park Inclusive playground not to exceed \$800,000 from city funds, contingent that we get the LWCF 50% grant match for the playground, and requesting that we get a proposal on a smaller size and a proposal for the full amount, depending upon what our options are with the grant. The motion was seconded by Member Redshirt.

Motion was made by Member Woods to amend the previous motion to make it contingent on any grants. The motion was seconded by Member Redshirt.

Vice-Chair Tenpenny called for a vote on the amendment to the motion, and it passed unanimously upon a vote.

Motion was made by the Vice-Chair Tenpenny to vote on the amended motion. and it passed unanimously upon a vote.

*Discussion and Possible Action Pertaining to Protecting City Trails from Development*

Member Woods asked the City Manager, Frank Marbury, what our options are for protecting our city trails.

City Manager Frank Marbury stated that we could possibly designate it as a park.
