Movies in the Park

Movies in the Park returned this summer, offering a fun, family-friendly evening where community members gathered to enjoy free movies and complimentary popcorn at the John C. Memorial Park. In June, the library featured *The Good Dinosaur* and *Jurassic World*, drawing a combined attendance of 463 participants. The program continues to provide a welcoming opportunity for families and friends to spend quality time together while enjoying free community entertainment.

Didgeridoo Down Under

The Didgeridoo Down Under Show was held at the city's PERA Building, where attendees experienced an engaging and interactive performance featuring traditional Australian music, cultural education, and entertaining audience participation. Open to all ages, the event provided a unique opportunity to learn about Australia's wildlife, history, and Indigenous culture while enjoying a fun-filled performance. A total of 86 participants attended the program.

Boba Tea Party

The Boba Tea Party continues to be one of the library's most popular children's programs. During this month's event, participants created their own customized boba tea by choosing their preferred boba pearls, drink flavoring, and beverage base. The hands-on activity encouraged creativity while providing a fun and interactive experience for children. The program welcomed 91 attendees.
